URBAN FORESTRY TECHNICIAN – REGULAR FULL TIME

This position involves moderately complex technical field work and public relations work related to urban forestry policies, practices and procedures. The incumbent inspects trees on city property, identifies hazards and problems, determines appropriate arboricultural treatment and recommends same to supervisor; performs skilled arboricultural work involving pruning, maintenance, planting and removal of trees; deals with the public regarding complaints or inquiries relating to tree matters; provides information and assistance to internal and external contacts regarding municipal tree matters; and, prepares a variety of reports regarding tree related work. Work is performed under general supervision and the incumbent exercises considerable independence of judgement and action in technical areas of work. Unusual matters or more complex problems are referred to a supervisor who reviews work performance in terms of effectiveness of service rendered and conformance with established policies.
